Lively District Secondary School Innovative Integrated Technology (InIT) Program



The school of Innovative Integrated Technology (InIT) provides students with specialized programming that combines a variety of core subjects with our high caliber technology classes. LDSS works in partnership with businesses and industries to provide relevant and meaningful activities to students through job shadowing, field trips and certifications that will prepare students to be competitive in a global market. The InIT program will also encourage the integration of personal electronic devices within the classroom, which is a very unique feature to this program. Lively District Secondary School offers a program of Innovative Integrated Technology. Students registered in this program are eligible for bussing from anywhere within the boundaries of Rainbow Schools.

Admission is based on all of the following:

- recommendation of Grade 8 academic teacher(s) and /or the principal
- good work ethic and positive approach to their learning
- excellent attendance (no unauthorized absences)
- learning skills that suggest self-discipline and commitment to learning
- completion of the application form with the necessary documentation

Standards for Ongoing Participation:

Students who have demonstrated success in the Grade 9 Innovative Integrated Technology program will be admitted to the second year of the InIT program. These students will have demonstrated that they have a strong academic background in the core subjects as assessed by their Grade 9 teachers in consultation with the InIT coordinator and a strong commitment to learning.

InIT Certification:

College bound students will be required to obtain six technology courses within their four years and maintain a minimum 70% average within all tech courses in order to obtain an InIT certificate upon graduating. University bound students will be required to obtain four technology courses within their four years and maintain a minimum 70% average within all tech courses in order to obtain an InIT certificate upon graduation.

The application package for the Innovative Integrated Technology Program is attached. *Incomplete applications may cause delays in processing.* Completed packages should be forwarded to the main office at Lively District Secondary School. Once the application is reviewed, students will be notified of their acceptance into the program.
